Ezra 6:15 Cross References

John 10:22: "...it was at Jerusalem the feast of the dedication, and it was winter..."

<u>Psalm 81:3</u>: "Blow up the trumpet *in the new moon* in the time appointed, *on our solemn feast day*"

<u>Ezekiel 45:17</u>: "...the feasts...the new moons...the sabbaths...all solemnities of the house of Israel..."

<u>Romans 14:5</u>: "One man esteemeth one day above another: another esteemeth every day alike. *Let every man be fully persuaded in his own mind*"

<u>II Corinthians 8:2</u>: "...the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded unto the riches of their liberality"

II Chronicles 7:5: "And king Solomon offered a sacrifice of twenty and two thousand oxen, and an hundred and twenty thousand sheep: so the king and all the people dedicated the house of God"

Zechariah 4:10: "...who hath despised the day of small things?"

Mark 12:42-44: "And there came a certain poor widow, and she threw in two mites, which make a farthing. And He called unto Him His disciples, and saith unto them...this poor widow hath cast more in, than all they which have cast into the treasury: For all they did cast in of their abundance; but she of her want did cast in all that she had, even all her living"

<u>II Chronicles 11:16,17</u>: "...out of all the tribes of Israel such as set their hearts to seek the Lord God of Israel came to Jerusalem, to sacrifice unto the Lord God of their fathers. So they strengthened the kingdom of Judah"

<u>Numbers 19:13</u>: "Whosoever...purifieth not himself...because the water of separation was not sprinkled upon him, he shall be unclean..."

<u>II Chronicles 29:34</u>: "...the Levites were more upright in heart to sanctify themselves than the priests"

Ephesians 5:25,26: "Christ...loved the church, and gave Himself for it; that He might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word"

<u>Titus 2:13,14</u>: "...our Saviour Jesus Christ...gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from all iniquity, *and purify unto Himself a peculiar people*, zealous of good works"

<u>II Corinthians 7:1</u>: "...let us *cleanse ourselves* from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God"

Exodus 12:48: "And when a stranger shall sojourn with thee, and will keep the passover...let all his males be circumcised, and then let him come near and keep it; and he shall be as one that is born in the land..."

I Corinthians 5:6: "...a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump"

<u>I Corinthians 5:7,8</u>: "Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ *our Passover* is sacrificed for us. Therefore *let us keep the feast*, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth"

<u>Jeremiah 52:24-27</u>: "And the captain of the guard took Seraiah the chief priest, and Zephaniah the second priest...to the king of Babylon...and the king of Babylon smote them, *and put them to death*...thus Judah was carried away captive out of his own land"

<u>II Kings 22:8</u>: "And *Hilkiah the high priest* said...I have found the book of the law in the house of the Lord..."

<u>Psalms 106:28</u>: "They joined themselves also unto Baalpeor, and ate the sacrifices of the dead. Thus they provoked Him to anger...then stood up Phinehas, and executed judgment..."

<u>Proverbs 22:29</u>: "Seest thou a man *diligent* in his business? *He shall stand before kings*; he shall not stand before mean men"

<u>I Samuel 7:3</u>: "If ye do return unto the Lord with all your hearts, then put away the strange gods... from among you, *and prepare your hearts unto the Lord, and serve Him only*..."

<u>II Chronicles 19:3</u>: "...there are good things found in thee, in that thou hast taken away the groves out of the land, *and hast prepared thine heart to seek God*"

II Chronicles 20:33: "...the high places were not taken away; for as yet the people had not prepared their hearts unto the God of their fathers"
