Ezra 3:1 Cross References

Exodus 23:17: "Three times in the year all thy males shall appear before the Lord God"

<u>Leviticus 23:24</u>: "Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, *In the seventh month*, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, *a memorial of blowing of trumpets*..."

<u>Jeremiah 4:5</u>: "Blow ye the trumpet in the land: cry, *gather together*, and say, *Assemble vourselves*..."

<u>Matthew 13:30</u>: "...in the time of harvest, I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into My barns"

<u>Ezekiel 37:19</u>: "Thus saith the Lord...I will take...Israel...and will put them with... *Judah*, and make them *one*...and *they shall be one in Mine hand*"

Acts 2:46; 4:32: "And they, continuing daily with one accord... were of one heart and of one soul..."

Matthew 24:31: "He shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other"

<u>Leviticus 23:24,25</u>: "...a memorial of blowing of trumpets...Ye shall do no servile work therein: but ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the Lord"

Matthew 12:5: "...on the sabbath days the priests in the temple profane the sabbath, and are blameless"

II Chronicles 36:19: "they burnt the house of God, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem

<u>Deuteronomy 28:15,50-52</u>: "...if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the Lord...a nation of fierce countenance...shall besiege thee in all thy gates, until thy high and fenced walls come down, wherein thou trustedst, throughout all thy land..."

<u>Zechariah 2:4,5</u>: "Jerusalem shall be inhabited *as towns without walls...* for I, saith the Lord, will be unto her *a wall of fire round about...*"

<u>Isaiah 26:1</u>: "In that day...salvation will God appoint for walls..."

Exodus 29:38-41: "...offer upon the altar; two lambs...the one lamb thou shalt offer *in the morning*; and the other lamb thou shalt offer *at even*...an offering made by fire...a continual burnt offering throughout your generations..."

<u>Galatians 6:7,8</u>: "...God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption..."

- <u>Matthew 17:1-4</u>: "Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John...into an high mountain...and was transfigured before them: *and His face did shine as the sun*, and His raiment was white as the light...then answered Peter...Lord, it is good for us to be here...*let us make here three tabernacles*..."
- <u>Leviticus 23:34-40</u>: "...the feast of tabernacles...ye shall take you on the first day the boughs of goodly trees, *branches of palm trees*..."
- <u>John 12:12,13</u>: "...much people...when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, took branches of *palm trees*, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: *Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord*"
- <u>Psalm 137:1-3</u>: "By the rivers of Babylon, there we sat down, yea, we wept, when we remembered Zion....they that carried us away captive required of us a song; and...required of us mirth, saying, *Sing us one of the songs of Zion*"
- Ephesians 2:4-6: "God...hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus"
- <u>Haggai 2:3</u>: "Who is left among you that saw this house in her first glory? and how do ye see it now? is it not in your eyes in comparison of it *as nothing?*"
- <u>Zechariah 4:9,10</u>: "The hands of Zerubbabel have laid the foundation of this house...who hath despised the day of small things?"
- <u>Haggai 2:3,4</u>: "...is it not in your eyes in comparison of it as nothing? Yet now *be strong*, O Zerubbabel, saith the Lord; and *be strong*, O Joshua, son of Josedech, the high priest; and *be strong*, all ye people of the land, saith the Lord, *and work: for I am with you, saith the Lord of hosts*"
- <u>II Kings 17:24-33</u>: "the king of Assyria brought men...and placed them in the cities of Samaria *instead of the children of Israel*...then the king of Assyria commanded, saying, Carry thither one of the priests whom ye brought from thence; and...let him teach them the manner of the God of the land. Then one of the priests...and taught them how they should fear the Lord. *Howbeit every nation made gods of their own*"
- John 4:9: "...the Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans"
- <u>John 4:22</u>: "Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews"
- <u>II Kings 17:41</u>: "So they feared the Lord, and served their own gods...and served their graven images"
- <u>I John 2:1,2</u>: "...we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous: *and He is the propitiation for our sins...*"
